Gold Coast Forum on New Planning Laws

The State Government is currently developing new planning laws which will impact on all Gold Coasters, in the development of their city, their homes, workplaces and recreational opportunities. To ensure that everyone has the opportunity to understand the proposed new laws Gecko-Gold Coast and Hinterland Environment Council (Gecko) and the Environment Defenders Organisation (EDO) are holding a forum called a LawJam titled Planning Reform and the Community to be held at 6pm on Thursday 16th July, Robina Community Centre, Auditorium, Robina Town Centre Drive, Robina (opposite the shopping centre).

The LawJam will provide vital information to all:-

- Gold Coast residents interested in the impacts of planning laws on their community,
- Practitioners and students of planning, architecture, community development and engineering and more
- All conservation and environment organisations with concerns about retention of biodiversity conservation, public open space and community amenity.

- Brian Feeney, Retired City Planner, with decades of experience in planning and the impacts of planning on the quality of life of residents of the Gold Coast.

Following the presentations by the speakers the audience will have the opportunity to ask questions of any member of the panel.
